- **\Box** Total Population \approx 4.4 million
- Charities $\approx 25,000$
- Young people aged $12-25 \approx 20\%$
- Another great idea, but who's going to pay for it?
- How much funding is available?

- A few <u>nationally-significant</u>, proactive, systemschange, partnership projects
- Mainly youth employment focus (e.g. Youth Connections/Grow Our Own Workforce)

- One-off or development costs, preferred to recurring
- Incrementally-reducing funding through period of development
- Match-funding other income sources promote `sustainability'
- No need to 'grow like Topsy'
- Scale-up to national coverage necessary? wise?
- Mainstreaming' to existing major organisation
- Merger, collaboration, back-office sharing



- Measure outcomes, demonstrate effectiveness & cost-effectiveness
 show you are making a difference
- Funders have to decide where they think their limited money will do the most good

WTMF funding

- To increase community groups' joint efficiency or effectiveness - e.g. merging or sharing facilities, systems or staff
- Small-scale exploration of an idea for a collaborative initiative
- Small-scale start-up costs (e.g. equipment, consultancy expertise) for a collaboration
- Not 'business-as-usual' projects

WTMF 2009-15

- 938 applications received
- 201 collaborative initiatives funded
- Involving 731 community groups
- Average grant \$9,358
- Application/grant numbers p.a. increasing
- Positive evaluation results
